

## OSCCAR Logic for Counting Job Referrals

- The OSCCAR counts job referral services (codes 451 & 449) with a status of 'Hired' (code 275) according to the transaction date.
- The OSCCAR counts job referral services (codes 451 & 449) with a status not equal to 'Hired' according to the service date.

//i.e. service date for job referrals except hired, transaction date for everything else, including job referrals – hired.
